Local Rules - Main Course

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
 - Beyond all fences or hedges bordering the course.
 - 1st, 2nd, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th holes - beyond the white posts.
 - On or beyond the car park (including metalled pathways) or approach road.
 - Beyond the white posts surrounding the practice green, pathways and flowerbeds.
 - Beyond the fence to the left of the 18th hole surrounding the practice area.
- STONES IN BUNKERS (RULE 24-1)**
Stones in the bunkers are movable obstructions, and may be removed without penalty.
- STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2)**
If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance to Rule 24-2b (within one club length of the nearest point of relief).

- SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)**
All pop up sprinkler heads, travelling sprinklers and their hoses are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2b. (within one club length of the nearest point of relief).
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**
The public footpath between the marker posts at the 17th hole is an immovable obstruction and relief may be obtained under Rule 24- 2b.
- Please ring bell on holes 7 and 11 to alert the group behind it is clear to tee off.**
- AVOIDING SLOW PLAY**
Please ensure that your party does not hold up groups behind you. If you lose a hole on the group in front you must let any groups waiting behind through.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

To ensure everyone enjoys their game of golf to the full please observe the following: Please familiarize yourself with the current Centre Policy regarding bookings and playing golf. Ensure you check in at the Pro Shop twenty minutes in advance of your tee time and be ready to play on the tee ten minutes in advance. HGC cannot guarantee entrance to the golf course if you are late on the tee for your time. Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers. Please keep trolleys and bags off tees and green aprons. Players without a shirt or wearing athletic style shorts are not permitted. Players must have their own bag of clubs. Sharing a set of clubs is not permitted. No distressed clothing, Golf shoes or trainers must be worn.

INSURANCE & SAFETY

Everyone is advised to ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. In the interests of safety, please ensure no one is in range, before playing a shot.

All players are reminded that all golf is played at own risk including all weather conditions.
