Local Rules - Maybury Course

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

- Beyond any fence or hedge bordering the course.
- On or beyond the car park or approach road.

2. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions and may be removed without penalty.

3. STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2)

If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with rule 24-2b (within one club length of the nearest point of relief).

4. SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)

All pop-up sprinkler heads, travelling sprinklers and their hoses are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under rule 24-2b.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

To ensure everyone enjoys the game of golf to the full please observe the following:

Please familiarise yourself with the current Centre Policy regarding bookings and playing golf. Ensure you check in at the Pro Shop twenty minutes in advance of your tee time and be ready to play on the tee ten minutes in advance. HGC can not guarantee entrance to the golf course if you are late on the tee for your time. It is the duty of every golfer to keep pace with the game in front, and not just ahead of those behind. Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers. Please keep trolleys and bags off tees and green aprons.

Players wearing distressed clothing are not permitted. Players must have their own bag of clubs and sharing a set is not permitted.

INSURANCE & SAFETY

Everyone is advised to ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. In the interests of safety, please ensure no one is in range before playing a shot. Please be aware of flying balls. Golf shoes must be worn. **All players are reminded that all golf is played at own risk including all weather conditions.**
